Recommendations for the ExCo

Common Fund contributions remain the same for 2023.

Contracting Party: USD 8,800

• Sponsor: USD 4,400

Limited Sponsor: USD 2,933

- 2. Contracting Parties agree to a 1 year (2023) pause of membership fees for the 6 GN-SEC Centres (CCREEE, EACREEE, ECREEE, RCREEE, SACREEE, SICREEE).
 - In 2024, Centres start paying the Sponsor membership fee or withdraw from the TCP.
 - Each Centre asked to agree to this proposal and commit to a minimum of 3 specific SHC activities (e.g., in-person participation at 1 ExCo meeting per year, participation in x Task, developing and presenting a Task Concept Paper, etc.).
 - Rationale
 - o SHC TCP benefits from the geographically diverse groups in developing countries and their growing solar market.
 - o GN-SEC members benefit from knowledge exchanges and participation in Tasks and other TCP activities.
 - UNIDO will no longer fund GN-SEC membership fees starting in 2023, and some Centres are still assessing how best to participate in the TCP and Tasks and identifying national experts.
 - o GN-SECs could reallocate these funds to fund an expert in a Task, travel to ExCo Meetings, etc.
- 3. Approve Work Plans and Budgets for Bärbel Epp/solarthermalworld.org, Randy Martin/website, and Pam Murphy/SHC Secretariat.

Items to Note

1. Proposed 2023 Budget

• USD 233,009 budget is a decrease of \$30,131 from the 2022 Budget

2. Member Contributions

- Includes all Contracting Parties, Sponsors ISES and ECI, and the Limited Sponsor ergSol
- It does not include GN-SECs (CCREEE, EACREEE, ECREEE, RCREEE, SACREEE, SICREEEE)
- 3 members with payments in arrears
 - Italy (2019-2021), ECREEE (2019-2021), and RCREEE (2021-2022)

3. Changes to the Budget

- Trade Association Meetings. Omitted
- OA Meetings. Decreased from \$500 to \$300 (for snacks and drinks during OA meetings)
- Task Brochures. Decreased from \$5,000 to \$2,000 (\$1,000 per brochure instead of \$2,500). 2 brochures expected in 2023.
- SHC Solar Award: No budget. Next award planned for 2024.
- Solar Decathlon Europe: No budget. Next event in 2025.
- EuroSun: No budget. Next conference 2024.
- Contract Work
 - Secretariat Budget. Proposed 15-hour increase to 1,165 hours (or \$1,275). Based on 5-year average of 65 hours over budget.
 - o Website Maintenance Budget. No proposed increase. The 2023 Work Plan and Budget are included with this report.
 - Solarthermalworld.org Budget. A decrease of \$3,756 is proposed. Budget changes include 25 news instead of 30.
 Includes new line item of \$2,500 to cover the devaluation of the Euro. It will only be used if needed.
 - Solar Heat Worldwide Budget. No proposed increase for the 2024 report.
